Claims overview – Excess specification

What is the excess?

Each year, you pay part of the medical expenses. This amount is called the excess. The government determines the amount every year. This is € 385 for 2023. Each year, you can opt for an increased or voluntary excess. You will pay more health care expenses out of the excess, but your premium is lowered. The excess does not apply to, among other things, the general practitioner, obstetric care and treatment for children younger than 18 years. What is the difference between excess and statutory personal contribution?

Everybody in the Netherlands has to pay a statutory personal contribution for some medicines and medical devices. In most cases, the government determines the level of this contribution and to which medicines and medical devices it applies to. In some cases we are the ones who determine that. The excess and the statutory personal contribution have nothing to do with each other.
